Additional Information

As compared to the first cycle of assessment through IQAC setup, many achievements have been made during second and subsequent cycles. These achievements are related to curricular, co-curricular, extracurricular and administrative fields. Some of these achievements are –

- a) Five faculty members have completed Ph. D. degree
- b) Two faculty members have completed M. Phil degree.
- c) Faculty members completing research related activities have increased.
- d) Use of IT facilities in teaching-learning activities has been introduced.
- e) Number of books in the library has almost doubled.

Shifting of College to the New Building: The College used to function in the old building belonging to the parent society since its establishment in the year 1993. The functioning was on shared basis between high school, junior college and senior college. As the Senior College was required to work for limited hours every day, it was considered as the main hurdle in the hassle-free working of the senior College, particularly for its teaching-learning activities. Keeping in mind this problem and the future needs, the IQAC of the College persistently requested and convinced the management of the parent society the need for construction of a new building. The construction of the new building was initiated in the year 2006. Resultantly, the College has been shifted to the new premises on 27-11-2019. The building has been planned to fulfill not only present but also future needs of the College. The building is located in a place surrounded by lush greenery and is free from the hustle and traffic of human movement. The new building has the provision of required number of spacious and well-ventilated class rooms, a spacious library, administrative unit principal's cabin, board room etc. With the shifting of the College to the new premises, anyone can expect improvement in the working of the College. In the shifting of the College to the new building, the IQAC of the College has tried at its best.

Preparation of Academic Calendar: This calendar is prepared at the beginning of each and every year. This is aimed to streamline the day-to-day activities of the institution and also to avoid lapses and undue deviations. All the academic activities, throughout the year are undertaken keeping in mind the academic calendar. Thus the academic calendar provides direction to all the activities of the institution. Also academic time-table in each year is maintained by the IQAC.
