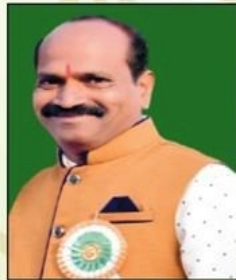

Patpanhale Education Society, Patpanhale, Tal. Guhagar, Dist. Ratnagiri (M.S.) established in the year 1962, took permission from the Government of Maharashtra to start its Patpanhale Arts, Commerce and Science College in the year 1992. The college is located at Patpanhale-Shringartali, Tal. Guhagar, Dist. Ratnagiri (M.S.). It is affiliated to the University of Mumbai. Initially the management started its Arts Programme and later on Commerce Programme with 09 academic departments (Marathi, Foundation Course, English, Political Science, Rural Development, History, Economics, Commerce and Accountancy). Almost all students are from rural areas and around 50% of them are from socially backward and downtrodden sections of the society. Girl students are around 55%. It is a common feature of the parents and the students that after passing 12th standard examination, students either go to Mumbai for jobs or discontinue their education. The management and the staff of the college have been taking very hard and sincere efforts to attract them for getting higher education. Consequently, we achieved a lot in this direction. We work always in the direction towards our vision, mission, objectives and values set for enhancement of quality education.

In the long way of advancement, the college has attained certain landmark achievements such as assessed and accredited by the NAAC, Bangalore with C++ grade in the year 2004, getting permanent affiliation from University of Mumbai in 2007-08, enlisting the college under sections 2(f) and 12(b) of the UGC Act and then assessed and accredited by the NAAC with B Grade in December 2013 and with B Grade again in September 2021 for 3rd cycle. The college has arranged a number of activities for the upliftment of students and the staff. It has also started Post Graduate Program (M.Com. in Business Management) in the year 2016. The college has also started a centre of Open University for students from educationally deprived sections of the society. The college has about 30 Cells and Associations for the development of the students. A number of faculty members are pursuing research work leading to Ph.D. Degree. The teachers have undertaken several research projects funded by University of Mumbai. The college has been shifted in the new building since 27th November, 2019. In all our endeavors, Hon. Shri. Bhalchandra Raghunath Chavan, President, Patpanhale Education Society, played a vital role and because of him and our consistent efforts towards academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular, Sports, Cultural, WDC, N.S.S. and other activities of cells and associations, created a concrete way for sustainable development of the students of this vicinity.

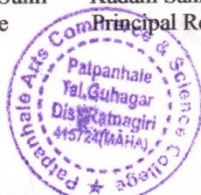

College Book Bank Scheme:

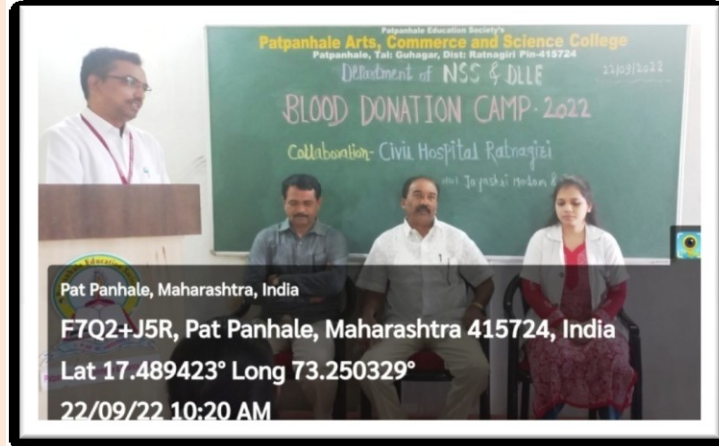
Conservation of Old Trees 14-08-2022

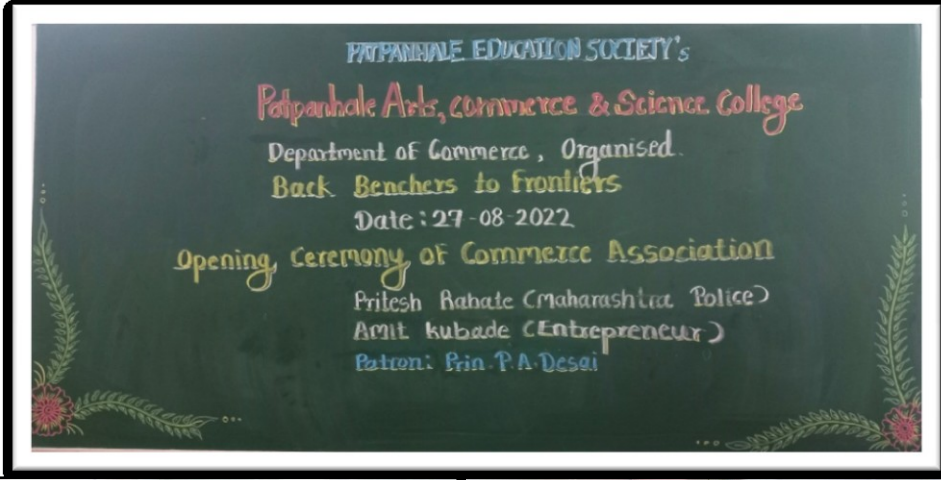
Book Distribution Program 12-08-2022

Sustainable Quality Enhancement through IQAC

Introduction :

Internal Quality Assurance Cell is the back-bone of any academic institution and the IQAC co-ordinator works as blood in the body. National Assessment and Accreditation Council proposes that every accredited institution should establish an IQAC. IQAC is constituted in every institution under the Chairmanship of the Head of the institution with heads of important academic and administrative units and a few teachers and a few distinguished educationists and representatives of local management and stakeholders. The IQAC became a part of the institution's system and works towards realization of the goals of quality enhancement and sustenance. The prime task of the IQAC is to develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the overall performance of institutions. The work of the IQAC is the first step towards internalization and institutionalization of quality enhancement initiatives. Its success depends upon the sense of belongingness and participation in all the constituents of the institution. The IQAC is the record-keeping body in the institution. IQAC must facilitate the creation of a student centric environment conducive to quality education and faculty maturation to adopt the required knowledge and technology for participatory teaching and learning process. IQAC have to collect feedback from all the stakeholders have to analyse them. IQAC works for organization of workshops, seminars, webinars. It prepares documents regarding programmes undertaken in the institution. The documentation is the crucial task for IQAC co-ordinator. The co-ordinator should look into the matter of internal and external audit, academic audit system. At the last of the academic year, the co-ordinator has to submit AQAR towards the NAAC.

Objectives :

- 1) To find out obstacles while preparing documents to be submitted towards NAAC.
- 2) To understand the criteria-wise information in proper manner.
- 3) To show the important role of IQAC co-ordinators in the accreditation process.
- 4) To spread knowledge about how to keep records and maintain properly throughout the year.
- 5) To make the strategic plan properly on the paper every year.
- 6) To channelize various bodies of the college in proper channel.
- 7) To make aware to the teachers for accreditation process of the college.
- 8) To guide the administration of the college properly while functioning.

Role of IQAC Co-ordinator :

The role of the coordinator of the IQAC is crucial in ensuring the effective functioning of all the stockholders. The coordinator of the IQAC may be a senior/competent person with experience and exposure in quality aspects. She/he may be a full-time functionary or, to start with, she/he may be a senior academic /administrator entrusted with the IQAC as an additional responsibility. Secretarial assistance may be facilitated by the administration. It is essential that the coordinator may have sound knowledge about the computer, data management and its various functions such as usage for effective communication. The IQACs may create its exclusive window tab on its institutional website for keeping the records/files of NAAC, Peer Team Reports, AQAR, and Certificate of Accreditation Outcomes and regularly upload/ report on its activities, as well as for hosting the AQAR. NAAC has launched Revised Accreditation Framework since July, 2017 and hence AQAR format also modified, in cognizance with the new methodology. The tools and parameters are designed in the new AQAR format are in such a way that the preparation of AQAR would facilitate the HEI's for upcoming cycles of Accreditation. Data collected/prepared infuses quality enhancement measures undertaken during the years. Further, it also adds quality enhancement and quality sustenance measures undertaken in teaching, learning, research, extension and support activities of the Institution. It is hoped that new AQAR would facilitate Educational Institutions for creating a good database at Institutional level for enhancing the quality culture.

Challenges before IQAC co-ordinator :

Institutions Accredited by NAAC need to submit an Annual self-reviewed progress report i.e. Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) to NAAC, through its IQAC. The report is to detail the tangible results achieved in key areas, specifically identified by the IQAC at the beginning of the Academic year. While preparing report the IQAC co-ordinator faces various problems which are as follows:

1) While preparing data of the Institution in Part-A :

Many colleges have not permanent principal in the colleges. The colleges arrange principals as in-charge for six months. The in-charge principals seem to be not responsible adequately about NAAC process. They have to teach the students in classrooms want to finish workload allotted to them and at the last he or she has to look after the college administration. Most of time the in-charge principals changed time to time. New person come in the chair. Hence, in-charge principal could not provide proper data for the AQAR preparation. While feeling data the mobile number and e-mail address changes as per in-charge principal.

2) Non awareness of website of the institution :

The website is handled and observed only by the IQAC co-ordinator mostly. Neither principal nor other staff members observe the website time to time. Most of the personnel don't know the address of institutions website too. As non-awareness about institutions website the co-ordinator suffer much more. Most of time the non-teaching staff, administrative staff does not provide proper information about the institution. The records doesn't keep properly by them according to NAAC requirement.

3) While preparing record of Curricular Aspects :

In this criterion NAAC asks about curriculum through well planed process. We can answer this question as the process of staff meetings, annual plan, academic calendar, time table, work diaries and cells & association etc. All these work are done by various staff members of the college. The IQAC co-ordinator have to collect & tabulate them and at last upload on the website. This task of collection of data is troublesome. Some staff members do not cooperate for this. Then NAAC asks for the process of continuous internal evaluation process. This CIE process varies with the teachers. Hence, collection of CIE records from all the teachers and prepare in uniform form is troublesome task to co-ordinator. Letters of Board of Studies, Academic council, Assessment certificates can be analyzed easily. To initiate certificate programmes is easy but keeping continue such activities is so hard. That time the co-ordinator has to play an important role to be continued the programme. The curriculum framed by University and the NAAC asks about crosscutting issues relevant to professional ethics, gender, human values etc. But the colleges cannot involve these ethical issues in the syllabi at own. It is not in hand of the colleges. Colleges has to teach only those syllabus which are given by the authorities of university. Colleges cannot be manipulated in the curriculum its own. All the courses have not project work, field work, internship. How can we give justice for this question? Hence, the number of students undertaking project work decreases and the marks also decreases. Feedback process is very nice but the stakeholders do not take seriously to filling the goggle links for feedback in mind. We have to insist the stakeholders to go through feedback link. A very small numbers of employers go through the feedback links.

4) While preparing record of Teaching-Learning and Evaluation :

Criterion II is very vast and important with regards marks. In the remote and hilly areas, there is less number of students survived. We cannot increase the number of students. Each and every college tries to do something much more for slow and advanced learners. These also vary with teachers. Clubbing the efforts made by teacher for slow and advanced learners is not easy process. Because some teachers having records and other not having properly. Covid-19 insists the institutions to enable ICT tools. But in rural area there is no internet facility enough and some students do not have smartphones also. Every teacher introduces new methods of internal evaluation. To clubbing those methods is not easy task for co-ordinator. Teachers offer the platform for students communicating programme and course outcomes through notice boards, website, WhatsApp groups, google classrooms etc. NAAC requires documents showing results sign up by authorities. But the authorities of university do not provide any letter to colleges regarding result. Then we cannot show and prove

the college results. Student satisfaction survey is nice process. Students demand some more facilities through this from institutions. This matter is related to employers side. IQAC just convey the messages of students towards employers.

5) While preparing record of Research, Innovation and Extension :

In criteria III, there is question regarding grants for research projects. But it is not necessary that the authority will release the grants. Colleges create an ecosystem for innovations for transfer of knowledge through various activities, but the teachers' dose not prepares proper paper work. Teachers presents their research paper in various journals and proceedings, but the NAAC rejects some research papers for not having in the UGC listed, UGC care listed journals etc. Extension activities carry out by the colleges with various modes such as orientation of students, plantation work, rallies, guest lectures, construction of mini dams, observing of various days regarding social issues. NAAC gives marks for awards for extension activities but not for participation. Every institution has NSS, NCC, YRC etc and they observe various programs such as Swachha Bharat Abhiyan, AIDS awareness, Gender issues etc. But sometimes they don't have proper records prepared by the concerned teacher. Collaborative activities for research, faculty exchange, student exchange, internship is not easily possible in the traditional courses such as Arts, Commerce and Science streams. Therefore MoU's could not take place in large. Then the co-ordinator cannot do anything regarding these activities.

6) While preparing record of Infrastructure and Learning Resources :

Generally the institutions are equipped adequately with infrastructure such as principal cabin, administrative unit, examination room, library, classrooms, staffroom, IQAC room, arts lab, commerce lab, play ground, parking place, water closet, CCTV surveillance etc. They have cultural and sports facilities generally. Some classrooms are with ICT enabled. Institutions prepares budget and audited as regular annual activity but the co-ordinator have to face problems while preparing AQAR with these audit report. Audit report not contains what co-ordinator want for AQAR preparation. Automation of library is must but the students' uses traditional methods of searching books in the library. Students prefer journals, magazines, books and not e-journals, e-magazines and e-books. Library never stops working. All the days of year library is opened. Staff and students are engage in the college only for 180 days out of 365 days. At last the percentage of uses of library declined. Institutions provide Wi-Fi- facilities but the students do not uses these facilities properly. Almost time they misuse the said facilities as amusement, entertainment. The college has large number of computers but only few computers are in working condition. Although there are many AMC's but at the time the institutions call the facilitator on phone calls who is near and dear with him. And the facilitator may be out of AMC's.

7) While preparing record of Student Support and Progression :

Large number of students benefited by scholarships and free ships but the authority does not send record to the colleges and amount deposits into students account directly. Then co-ordinator cannot find records of supporting documents to prepare AQAR report. Some scholarships are given by the colleges but the administration does not keep the record properly. Large number of students' benefited by guidance for competitive exams but the negligible number of students appears and qualified. Generally there are harassment cases but no record found on paper. So many students placed elsewhere but they do not make contacts to the college regarding their placement. So we cannot answer properly for placement of outgoing students. Many students qualify in competitive exams but being alumni they do not in contact with college after progression for higher education. University organizes youth festival at university level with labeled of Inter-collegiate competition, but the NAAC do not accept these awards as Inter-collegiate competition. Although there is a student council but students is not presenting them properly in the decision making process of the college. The colleges have alumni associations. Usually the alumni association does not make cash contribution. And NAAC assumed that the association or alumnus contribute in lakhs.

8) While preparing record of Governance, Leadership and Management :

Every activities of the institution are carried on keeping in mind the vision, mission and goals & objectives of the institution. Every institution has a strategic plan and them acts regarding too. Functioning of institution is as rule of Government also. Every institution observes e-governance methodology. The softwares are used for administration, finance & accounts which are bought from elsewhere, but the software for student admission & examination are provided by authorities through MKCL. So the institute cannot show ERP documents for these software. Generally institutions provides service benefits to the staff, travelling allowances, uniforms to the peons, washing allowances, deduction of LIC premium & provident funds. Sometimes administration denies the travelling allowances, fees of seminars, webinars, workshops, conferences registration etc. Generally all the staff members fulfilled faculty development programmes. They fulfilled refresher courses, orientation programs and short-term courses on time. Then there is question to coordinator that how to answer this question? Institution has performance based appraisal system, but there is a problem with issue of NET-SET affected faculty. So institution cannot fulfill CAS issues on time. Many a times funds generated by the sources which are not list in the audit report. Staff members donate some amount to the institution but the audit report not included it.

9) While preparing record of Institutional Values and Best Practices :

The institution gives importance to the safety of female students. The staff members always keep an eye on the entry of newcomers in the campus. Health facilities are provided for female students by calling local doctors. Working sign boards are displayed against ragging. These are measures initiated by institution for the promotion of gender equity in every institution. Every institution has waste management policies, water conservation policies, garden for greenery, disabled-friendly environment etc. The institutions observe different types of commemorative days throughout the year. Institutions celebrate constitution day, Independence Day, republic day, and various birth and death anniversaries for sensitization of students. Institutions observes national law day, voters day, international woman's day. Yoga day, AIDS awareness week etc as national and international commemorative events. All these activities are observed in the colleges but the record is not prepared properly on the paper by the concerned teacher. Hence, the co-ordinator has to make all these records for AQAR and it is challenging job for the IQAC co-ordinator to submit AQAR on stipulated time.

खेलों की दुनिया में भी देश की महिलाओं ने वर्ष 2022 में जीत हासिल कर देश का गौरव बढ़ाया। शीर्ष भारतीय बैडमिंटन खिलाड़ी और बैड मिंटन विश्व रैंकिंग में 7 वें स्थान पर काबिज पी. वी. सिंधु, ब्रिटेन के बर्मिंघम में हुए राष्ट्रमंडल खेल 2022 में महिला एकल बैड मिंटन में कनाडाई बैडमिंटन शटलर को 48 मिनट तक चले मुकाबले में हराकर राष्ट्रमंडल खेल का पहला स्वर्ण पदक अपने नाम करने में कामयाब हुईं। राष्ट्रमंडल खेलों में कांस्य और रजत पदक जीतने के बाद अब स्वर्ण पदक जीतकर पी. वी. सिंधु तीनों रंग के पदक जीतने वाली पहली भारतीय महिला शटलर बन गई हैं। इससे पहले वर्ष 2022 की शुरुआत में जनवरी माह में ही दो बार की ओलम्पिक पदक विजेता पी. वी. सिंधु को सीधे गेम में हराकर सैयद मोदी बैडमिंटन सिंधु ने भारतीय

खिलाड़ी मालविका बंसोड़ चैम्पियनशिप 2022 का महिला एकल खिताब जीता था. महिला वेटलिफ्टर मीराबाई चानूने बर्मिंघम कॉमनवेल्थ गेम्स 2022 में 49 किग्रा भार वर्गमें गोल्ड मेडल जीतकर देशका नाम रोशन किया. यह उनका दूसरा गोल्ड मेडल था. इससे पहले उन्होंने 2018 के गोल्डकोस्ट कॉमनवेल्थ गेम्समें गोल्ड मेडल जीता था. मीराबाई चानूका शुरुआती जीवन काफी गरीबीमें बीता है. वे घरके लिए ईंधन इकट्ठा करनेके लिए जंगलोंमें लकड़ियाँ चुनने जाया करती थीं. 12 वर्ष की उम्रसेही चानू वजन उठाती रही हैं. वे अपने भाई बहनोंकी तुलनामें अधिक वजनकी लकड़ियाँ आसानीसे उठा लेती थीं. बचपनसे किया गया उनका यह कठिन अभ्यास आखिरमें रंग लाया और वे देशकी चोटीकी वेट लिफ्टर बन गईं.

झूलन गोस्वामी इस वर्ष एकदिवसीय महिला क्रिकेट विश्वकपमें संयुक्तरूपसे सर्वाधिक विकेट लेनेवाली गेंदबाज बनकर उभरी. निकहत जरीन और नीतूने स्ट्रैंडजा मेमोरियल बॉक्सिंग टूर्नामेंटमें स्वर्ण पदक जीता. पश्चिमी महाराष्ट्रके सातारा की प्रियंका मोहिते 5 मई, 2022 को कंचनजंगा पर्वतकी चढ़ाई करने के बाद 8,000 मीटरसे अधिक ऊँची 5 चोटियोंको फतह करनेवाली पहली भारतीय महिला बन गई हैं. प्रियंका नुटक्की इस वर्ष भारतकी 23 वीं महिला गेंडमास्टर बनीं. 15 जनवरीको प्रधानमंत्री सुरक्षा चूक मामलेकी जाँच सुप्रीम कोर्टद्वारा इंदु मल्होत्राको सौंपी गई. शिवांगी सिंह रॉफेल फाइटर जेट उड़ानेवाली पहली भारतीय महिला पायलट बनीं. इसी वर्ष स्मृति मंधानाको वर्षकी बेस्ट महिला क्रिकेटर बनने के लिए आईसीसीने नॉमिनेट किया.

वर्ष 2022 में फिल्म और साहित्यके क्षेत्रमेंभी भारतीय महिलाओंने देशको गौरवान्वित किया. 60 के दशककी टॉप एक्ट्रेस रहीं आशा पारेखको भारतीय सिनेमामें अपने योगदान के लिए दादासाहेब फाल्के अवॉर्ड 2022 से नवाजा गया. फिल्मोंमें निभाए गए उनके किरदार आजभी यादगार बने हुए हैं. लेखिका गीतांजलिश्री की पुस्तक 'रेत समाधि' के अंग्रेजी संस्करण 'टॉम्ब ऑफ सेंड' को इसवर्ष अन्तर्राष्ट्रीय बुकर पुरस्कार मिला. यह हिन्दी भाषाकी पहली ऐसी साहित्यिक पुस्तक है, जिसे यह सम्मानित पुरस्कार मिला है. देशके लिए यह गौरवकी बात है कि हिन्दी भाषाके लिए इस पुरस्कारको पहलीबार एक नारी लेकर आई है, जिससे पता चलता है कि देशकी नारियाँ लेखनकी कला हो, खेलका मैदान हो या युद्धका मैदान, हर क्षेत्रमें भारतका नाम रोशन कर रही हैं. भारतीय लेखिका और कवयित्री मीना कंडासामीको 'हर्मन केस्टन पुरस्कार-2022' प्राप्त हुआ. आदिवासी बाहुल्य डिंडोरी जिलेके पाटनगढ़की सुपरिचित लोकचित्रकार दुर्गाबाई व्यामको बिना पढ़े-लिखे होनेके बावजूद कलाके क्षेत्रमें महत्वपूर्ण योगदान के लिए भारतके चौथे सर्वोच्च नागरिक सम्मान पद्मश्री के लिए चुना गया था. आयोजित समारोह के दौरान दुर्गा व्यामको यह सम्मान राष्ट्रपतिने प्रदान किया. दुर्गाने सीमित साधनों और कठिन परिस्थितियोंके बावजूद खुदको साबित किया. उन्होंने कठिन संघर्षकी चुनौतियोंको पार करते हुए जिलेकी लोककला को दुनियाभरमें प्रसारित किया. शतरंज खिलाड़ी सगी बहनों तनिष्का कोटिया और रिद्धिका कोटियाको भारत सरकारकी लोकप्रिय योजना 'बेटी बचाओ, बेटी पढ़ाओ' के लिए जिला गुरुग्रामका ब्रांड एंबेसडर बनाया गया है. रीतू खंडूरी उत्तराखण्ड राज्य विधानसभाकी पहली महिला स्पीकर बनीं. रुचिरा कंबोजको यूएनमें भारतका स्थायी प्रतिनिधि नियुक्त किया गया. कंबोज 1987 बैच की भारतीय विदेश सेवाकी अधिकारी हैं.

इस वर्ष सुप्रीम कोर्टने एक महत्वपूर्ण फैसला दिया कि माँको बच्चेका उपनाम चुननेका अधिकार है, क्योंकि वह बच्चेकी प्राकृतिक अभिभावक है.

कॉमनवेल्थ गेम्स 2022 (बर्मिंघम, इंग्लैंडमें आयोजित) में पुरुषोंकी अपेक्षा महिलाओंके अधिक मेडल इवेंट हुए. पहलीबार महिला क्रिकेटको खेलोंमें शामिल किया गया और भारतीय टीमने रजत पदक प्राप्त किया.

इसवर्ष एक दुर्लभ उपलब्धिके तहत त्जोर्नियर विमानपर सवार भारतीय नौसेनाकी 5 महिला अधिकारियोंने उत्तरी अरब सागरमें पहलीबार अपनेबूते समुद्री टोही और निगरानी अभियान पूरा किया. भारतीय नौसेनाने इस अभियानको ऐतिहासिक करार दिया है. सितम्बर 2022 में भारतके सर्वोच्च न्यायालयने यह फैसला दिया कि प्रत्येक महिलाको गर्भावस्थाके 20 से 24 सप्ताह के बीच कानूनी और सुरक्षित गर्भपात करानेका अधिकार है. चूँकि एक महिलाके शरीरके अंदर एक भ्रूण विकसित होता है, इसलिए उसे निर्णय लेनेका पूरा हक है. इससे कोई फर्क नहीं पड़ता कि महिला विवाहित है या नहीं, उसे अधिकार है कि वह गर्भावस्थाको अवधितक ले जाए या नहीं.

सितम्बर 2022 में 4 महिला न्यायाधीशोंको शीर्ष अदालतका हिस्सा बननेके लिए चुना गया था. इस सूचीमें जस्टिस इंदिरा बनर्जी, हिमा कोहली, बीवी नागरत्ना और बेला एम त्रिवेदी के नाम शामिल थे. 2022 में भारतीय महिलाओंकी एक बड़ी जीतके रूपमें भारतीय क्रिकेट कंट्रोल बोर्ड (बीसीसीआई) ने महिला क्रिकेटरोंको पुरुष क्रिकेटरोंके समान वेतन देनेकी घोषणा की. यह महिला और पुरुषके बीचके भेदभाव को खत्म करनेकी दिशामें एक बड़ा कदम है. इस वर्ष भारतीय नौसेनाने पहली बार महिला नाविकोंको शामिल किया, जो कि अपने आपमें एक बड़ी उपलब्धि है .इससे पहले महिलाओंको नाविक बननेका मौका नहीं मिलता था .भारतीय नौसेनामें करीब 3,000 अग्निवीर भर्ती हुए जिनमें3 41 महिला नाविक शामिल हैं.
